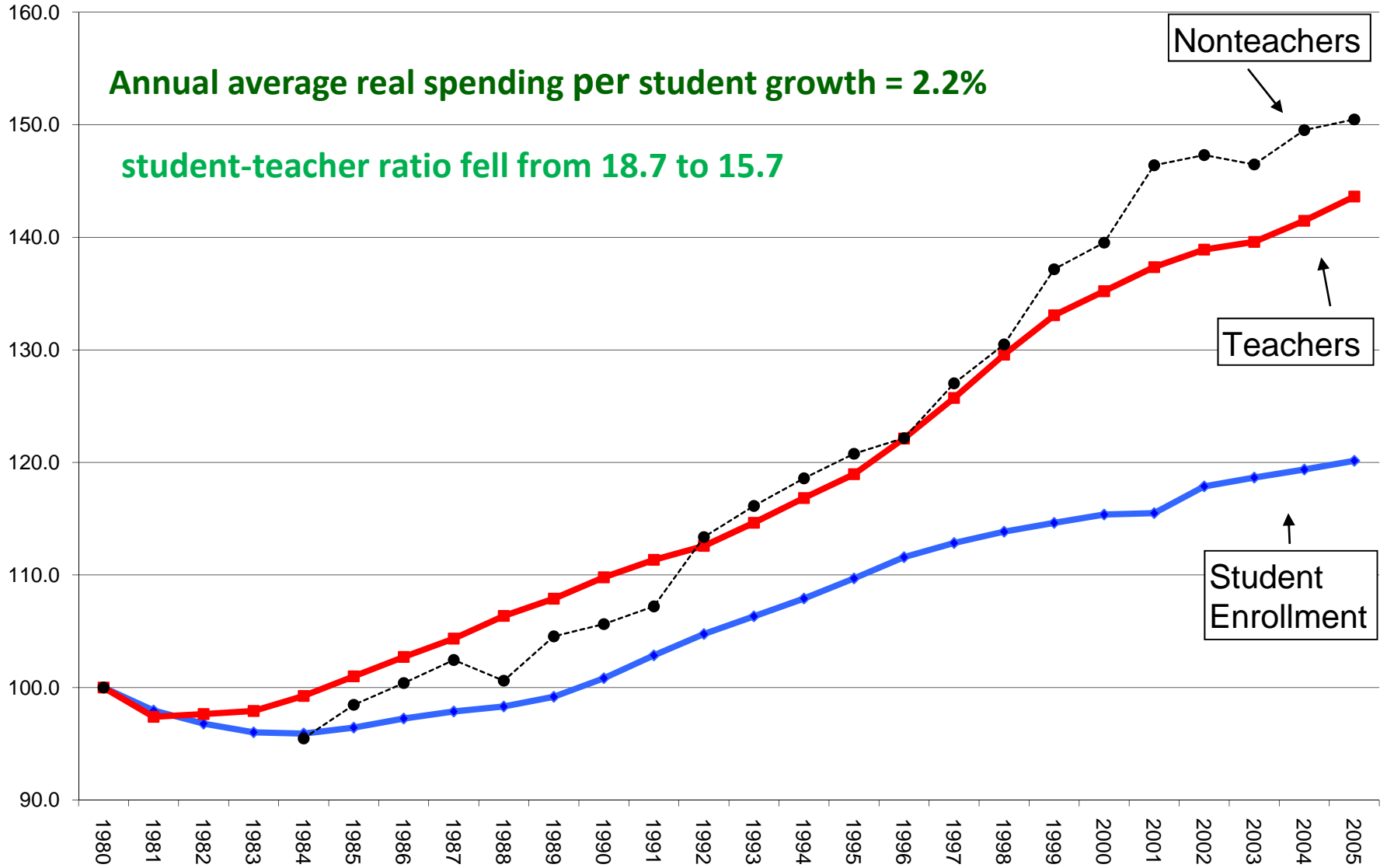

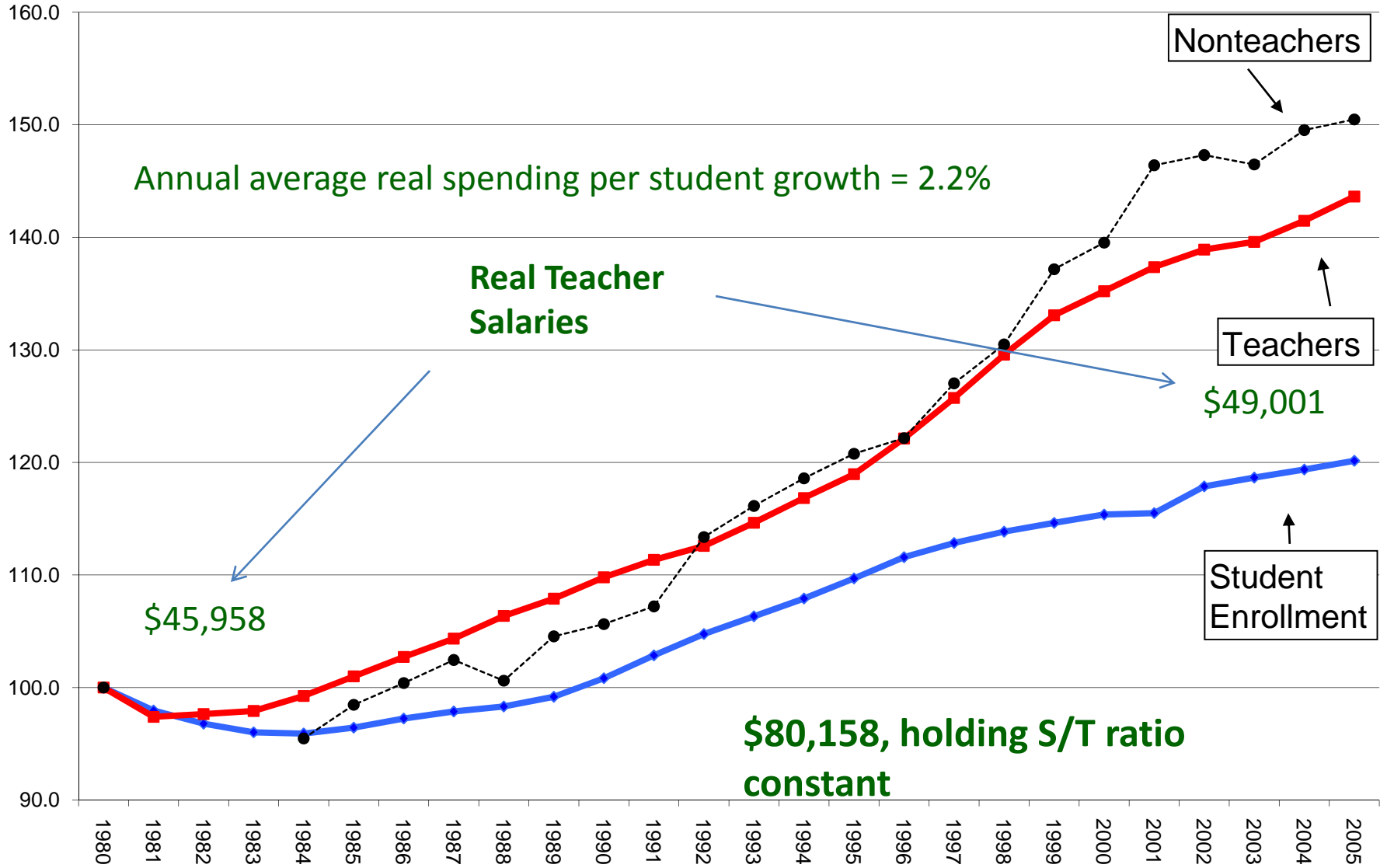

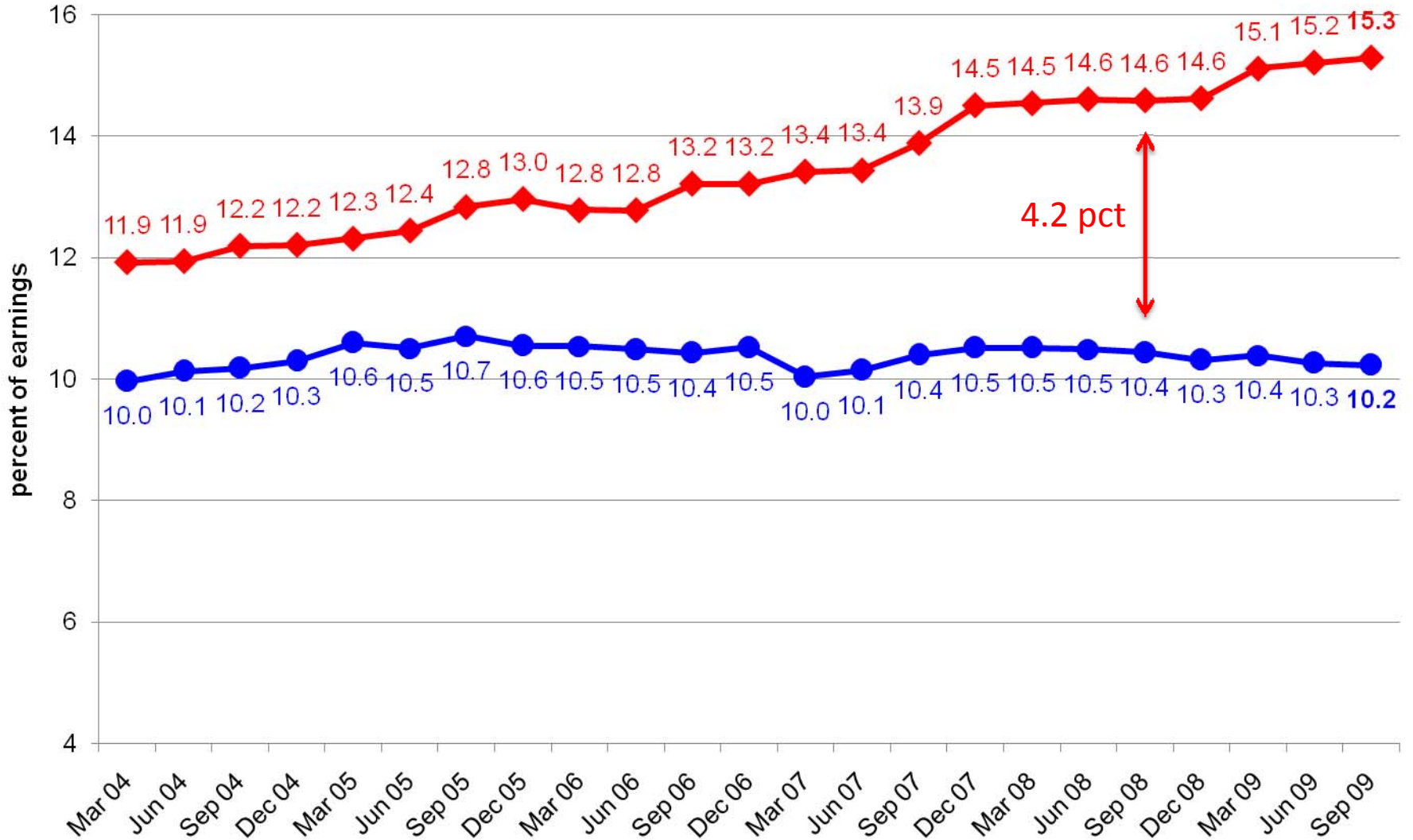
Student Enrollment, Teacher and Non-Teacher Employment In Public Schools: 1980 - 2005



Student Enrollment, Teacher and Non-Teacher Employment In Public Schools: 1980 - 2005



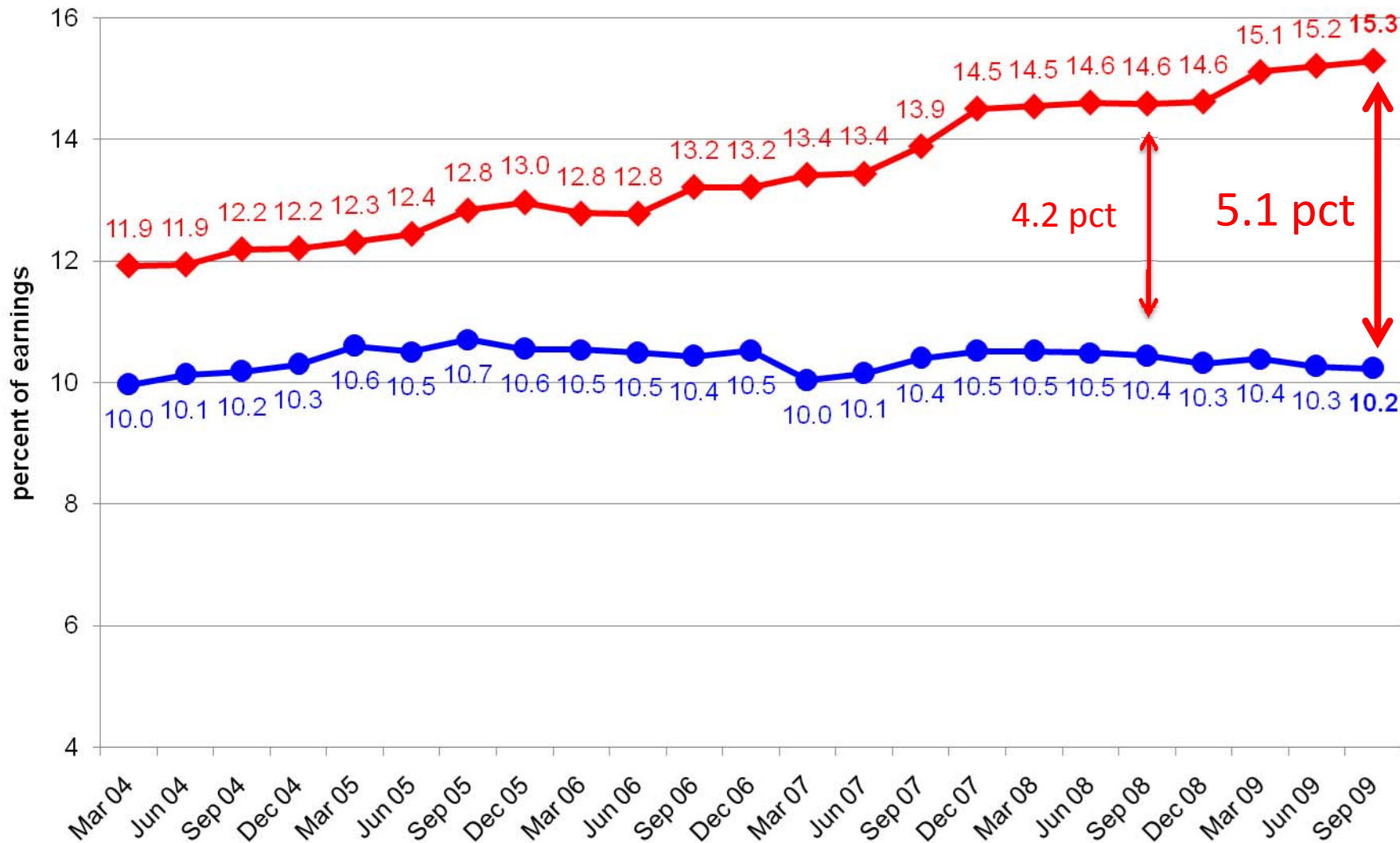
Employer contribution to public teacher and private professional retirement & Social Security

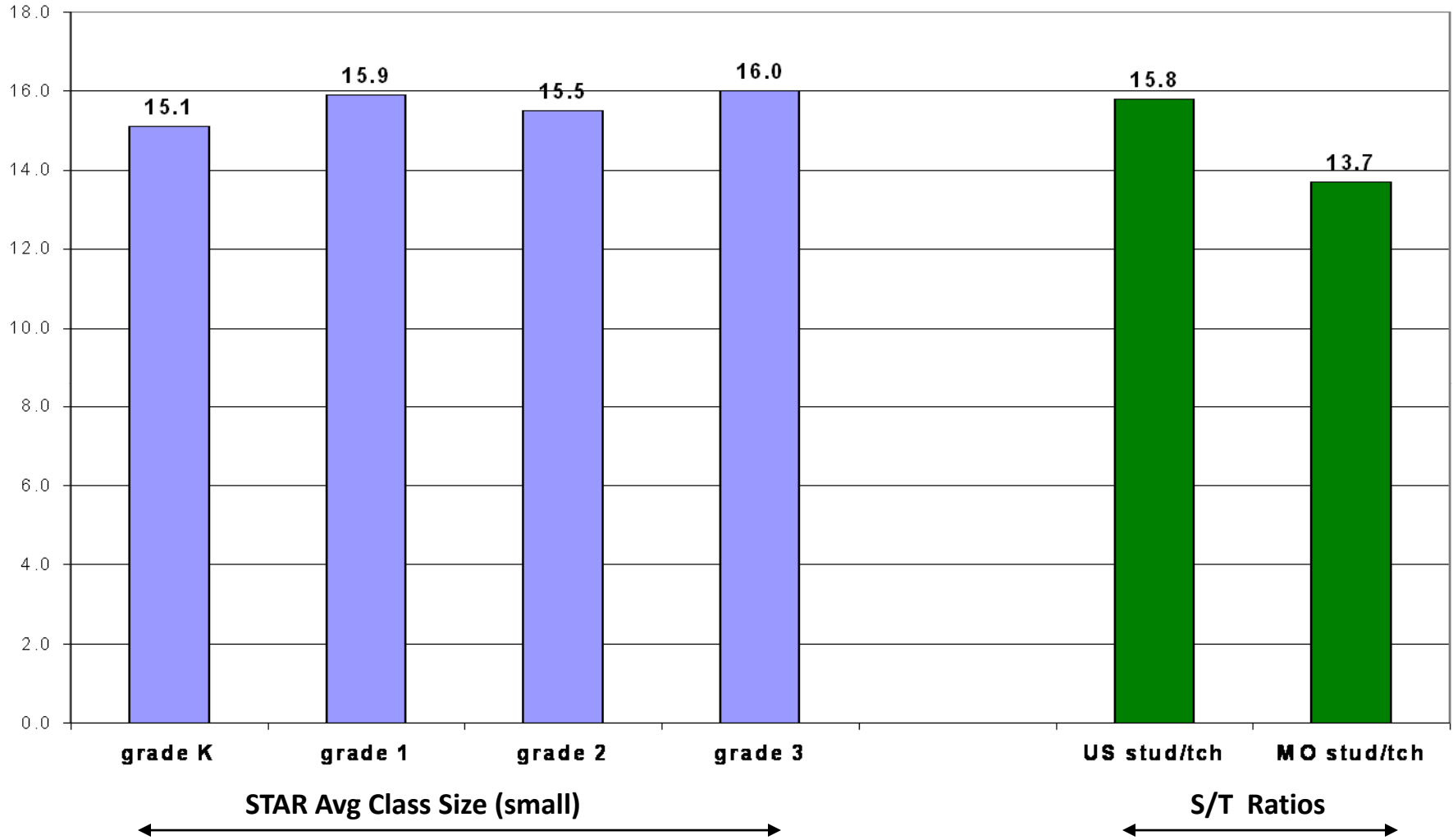
